INTERNET	Web site design	To maintain and develop the Aqueduct web site
	Social media	To manage Aqueduct's presence on Facebook etc.
	E book	To set up an e book so that we can publicise all the wonderful things that Jesus is doing in Pakistan
PUBLICITY	Volunteer organising	To manage those who volunteer for Aqueduct
	Publicity	To design publicity material and to publicise the work that Aqueduct is doing
	Church representation	To keep the needs of the people of Pakistan before your Church and to encourage their involvement in prayer, volunteering fund raising etc.
MONEY	Treasurer	To prepare monthly and annual accounts
	Gift Aid	To claim Gift Aid and comply with the regulation
	Microfinance	To plan a microfinance programme that works (Previous attempts have not been a success because a lack of understanding by the participants.)
SCHOOLS	Syllabus Development	To work with the School Board in Pakistan to develop a timetabled syllabus that will not only meet exam requirements but will also encourage understanding and inquisitiveness
	Teaching games	To write short descriptions of culturally appropriate, teaching activities
	Teacher training	To develop training that will enable the teachers to teach to meet exam requirements but will also encourage understanding and inquisitiveness
CHURCH	Pastors leadership / training camps	To train pastors in leadership and scriptural understanding. (Many are not well educated and have limited understanding of Biblical Truths.)
	Sunday school teaching	To work with the church in Pakistan to train and equip the teachers to give lively presentations of the Gospel
	Word on Wheels (Church planting)	To work with the local church in Pakistan to train young men for preaching, teaching and church planting
HEALTH	Healthy games	To write short descriptions of culturally appropriate, children's games
	Nutrition information	To write short descriptions of culturally appropriate foods that will improve nutrition and health.
